No food is provided by SBT on this course. Our marina has a cafe, bistro and the marina office sells snacks etc. Tea & coffee is free and available all week.

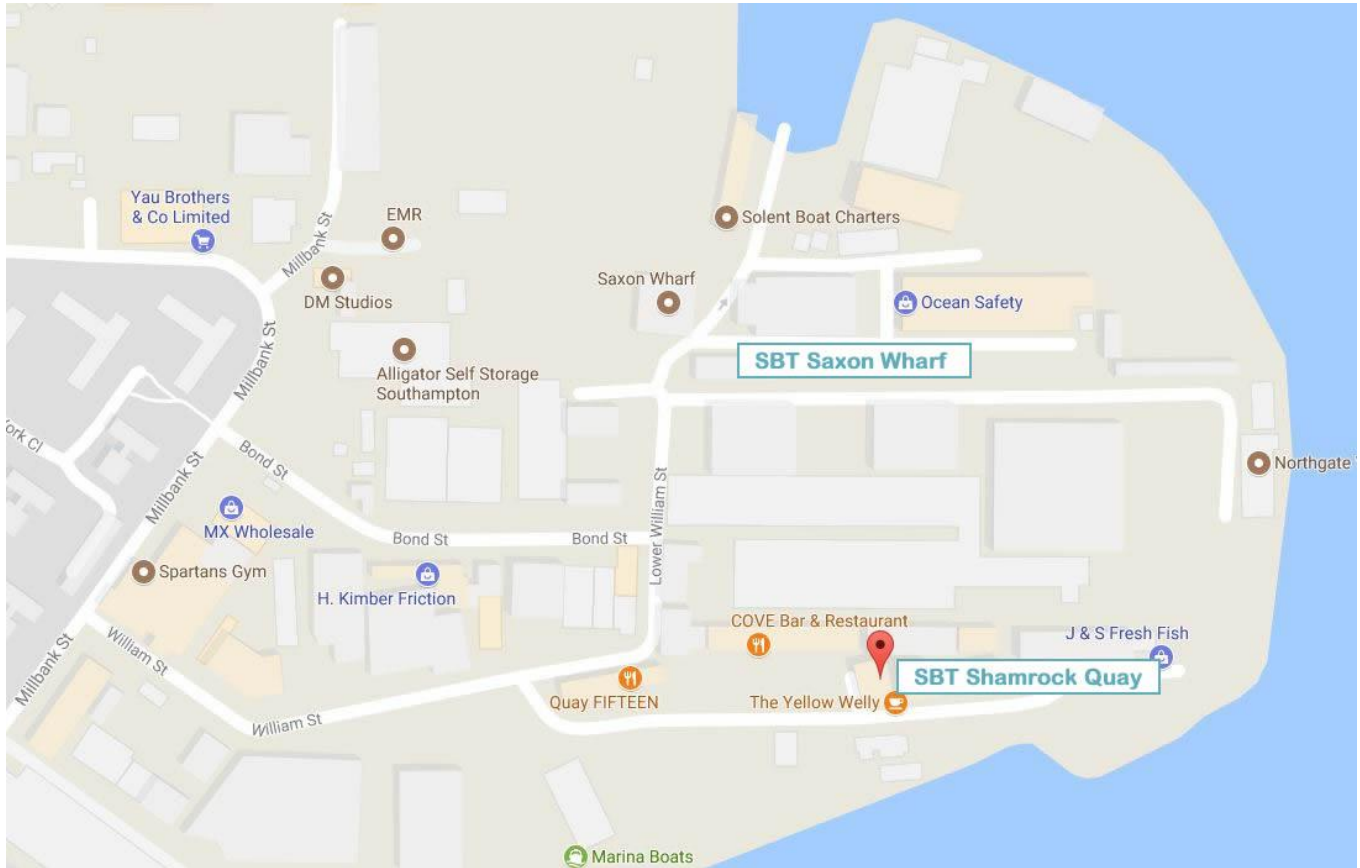
Car Parking

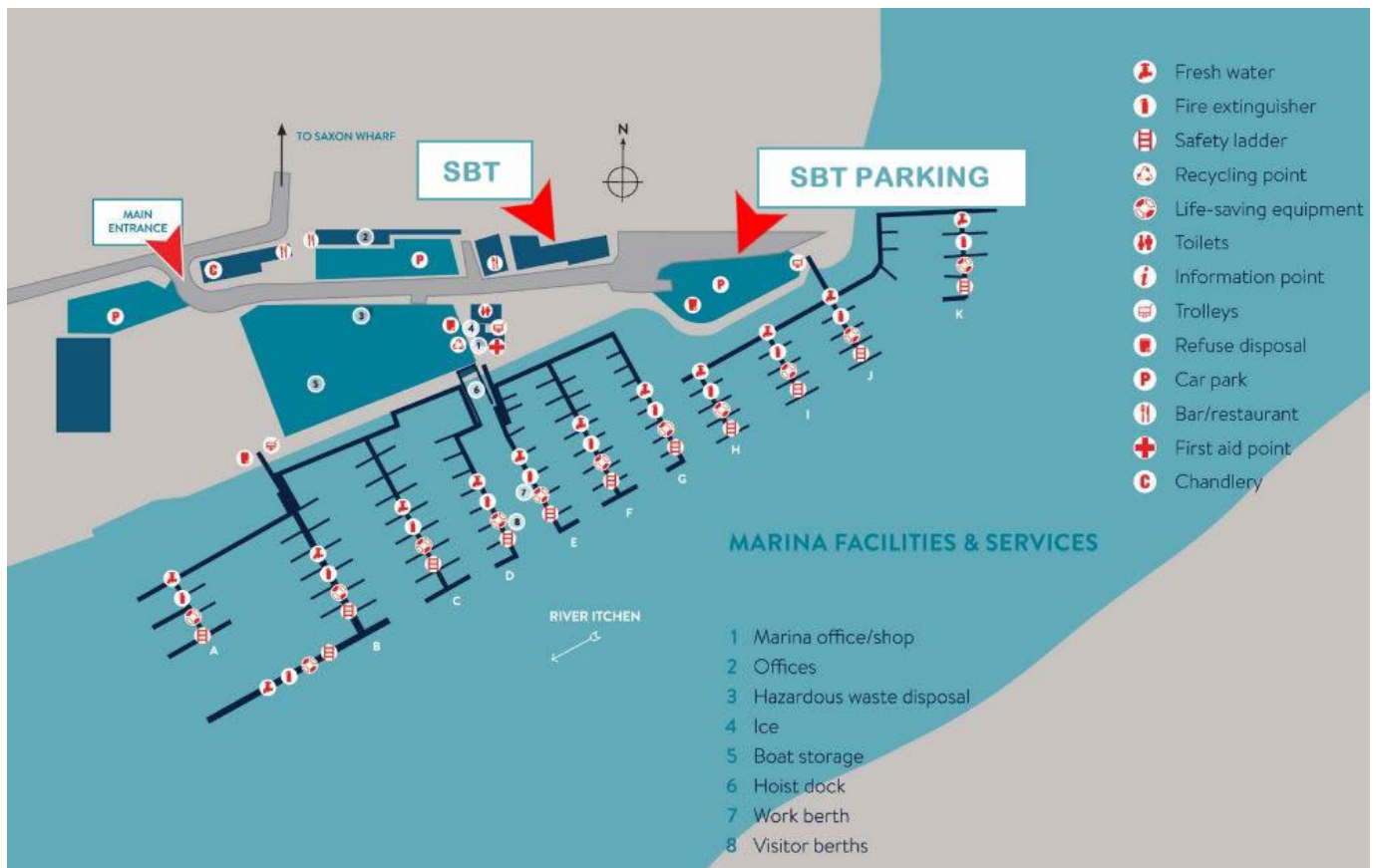
Directions To Our Training Centre
